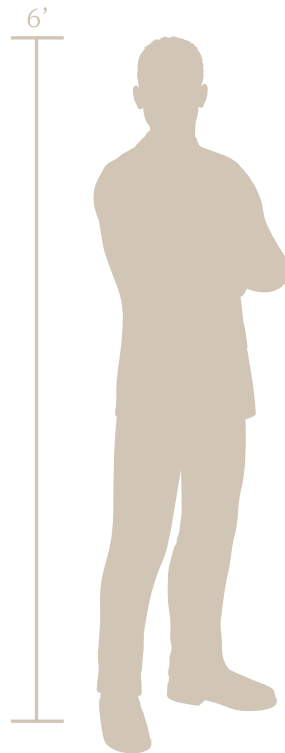
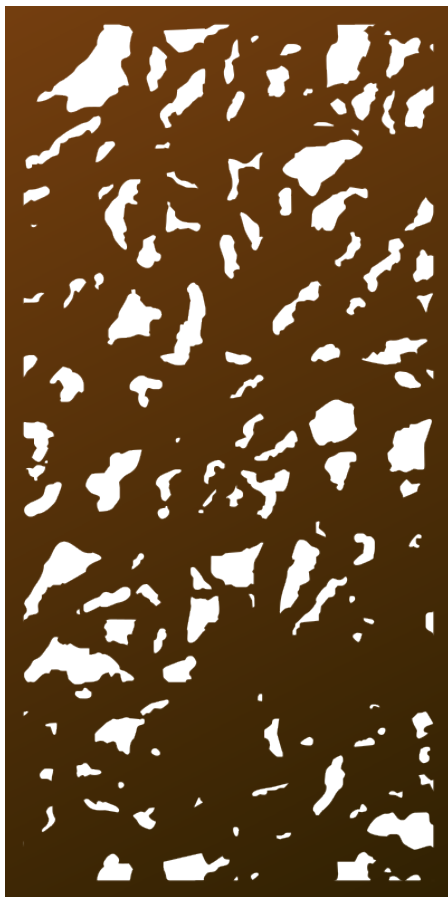


Winter Branches[©] (WBR)
