Custom Finish

While Parasoleil has its own line of proprietary powdercoat finishes that have been vetted, tested, and include our very own manufacturer's warranty, we understand that some projects require a custom finish solution. With countless options and dozens of suppliers to choose from, we recommend you consider the following factors when selecting a custom powdercoat to specify:

IS THE POWDER READILY AVAILABLE?

Verify with the supplier that the powder you want is not on back order and that the lead time is reasonable for your project requirements.

IS THE POWDER UV PROTECTED?

Some powders, particularly bright, primary colors, have a tendency to fade more quickly, even in interior applications, when exposed to sunlight. A UV protected powder has been tested and verified to hold up much better to sun exposure.

CAN THE POWDER BE APPLIED IN A SINGLE STEP?

We can only ensure a dependable process and lead time with single step finishes.

CHECK THE GLOSS LEVEL

Matte finishes tend to be less durable than higher gloss finishes as they don't shed water as easily and tend to trap debris.
